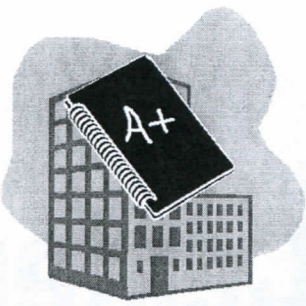
- ◆ They begin with a **diagnostic assessment** to find out exactly where your child's reading and math skill levels are.

### SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (SES): QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

**How are students assessed?** Gateway administers a nationally-recognized norm-based test in reading/language and math that has been approved by the Illinois State Board of Education. Parents, students, and selected school personnel will be given the results in an easy-to-understand format.

**How is progress measured?** Gateway measures progress daily based on the work completed by each student. Gateway also administers a pre-test and posttest to show objective results.

**Materials needed?** Gateway supplies all materials, including books, paper, pencils, etc.

**What instructional methods are used?** The teacher uses direct instructional methods, guiding and answering questions as each student completes the individualized tutoring program.

**Who will tutor the students?** Certified teachers who specialize in tutoring children in the subjects being presented.

**How many students per teacher?** 3 to 5

**What is the success of the program?** 100% of our students have improved 1 or more grade levels within 40 hours of instruction. (Please see brochure for specific requirements.)

**Where will the students be instructed?** Students will attend tutoring sessions at their school in a traditional classroom setting.

**What subjects are focused on?** Reading/Language & Math

**Are Bilingual or Special Education students eligible?** Yes, but it depends on the availability of our instructors.

**How often do students attend?** Students attend twice a week for one hour or once a week for 2 hours.

**How many hours will each student receive?** 30 hour minimum

**How do my students get started?** The parent notifies the district that they have chosen Gateway Learning Center as their provider. Then, an authorized person from the district will provide written verification of eligibility to Gateway Learning Center with the student's name, phone number, and parent's name. We will call the parents to begin services.
