Limestone Community High School was formed in 1953 as a new school district, accepting students in grades 9-12 from area grade schools. We are located in Bartonville, Illinois, just south of the Greater Peoria Regional Airport, within miles of Interstate I-474. Military installations at the airport gave the school its nickname of the "Rockets," a symbol we wear with pride in our programs and our community.

Our facility covers over 190,000 square feet of land, and sits on a beautiful 77 acre campus. The original building has been augmented, with additions built in 1959, 1966, and 1999.

Our athletic fields surround our building, including Frank Leach Football Stadium and the N.T. Endsley Sports Complex of tennis courts, softball diamonds, and soccer fields.

Eight administrative personnel round out our faculty, which consists of 144 full time employees. Our new teachers are assisted with a mentoring program, and our staff works to make everyone, teachers and students, feel safe and welcomed.

Our teachers continue to rise to the challenge of educating our students; with fully equipped computer labs, a modern library with electronic catalogues, computers in every classroom, and T1 technology throughout our facility, we work to prepare our students for their futures, and over 50% of our students seek further education after graduating. With assistance programs like our CORE team, which identifies and serves at-risk students, and our student support groups,

Limestone's staff provides assistance in academics, with grief, peer relations, and with career choice.
